### **London Array serves notice under Regulation 19 of Further Information**

#### **Proposed development at land north of Cleve Hill, Graveney, Faversham, Kent**

**WE GIVE NOTICE THAT** London Array Limited applied to Swale Borough Council of Swale House, East Street, Sittingbourne, Kent ME10 3HT on 6 June 2005 to construct a substation and associated construction facilities; associated earthworks; an access road; and laying up to six cables from the substation to the limit of Swale Borough Council's jurisdiction in the Swale. That application was accompanied by an Environmental Statement.

Following the decision by Swale Borough Council to refuse to grant planning permission for the development, the application is now the subject of an appeal to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government.

Further information is available in the form of an environmental assessment of an updated design for the substation (to be considered with the design which accompanied the Planning application).
